What we offer you

The Department for Innovation in Medical Education (DIME) and the University of Ottawa Skills and Simulation Centre (uOSSC) are offering a Fellowship in Medical Education/Simulation. The overall aim of this fellowship is to prepare the candidate for an academic career as a clinician educator.

The program will include:

- Training through the Health Education Scholar's Program; a structured formal weekly education session from September-May that covers a broad overview of the field of health professions education (curriculum, teaching and learning, assessment, research methodology and leadership).
 - Mentorship from both MDs and PhDs
- The initiation, design and conduct of innovative research relevant to the field of health professions education and practice.
 - involvement in DIME activities; journal club, rounds, research day
 - Optional Training in simulation through a formalized program (FEAST)

DIME and the uOSSC have established collaborations with the Medical Council of Canada and the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons Canada.
