Most important among these is the prospective fellow, The Nephrology Partners of Ottawa (funding source). Two streams are available – depending on the trainee's interest and future goals.

Core Clinical Hypertension Experience (6 months minimum)

- a) 6 months of Hypertension clinic
- b) 24 ABPM review
- c) Weekly meeting with supervisor to review reading list
- d) Presentation of key topics at Monthly Hypertension Rounds

Clinical Stream (6 months)

Remaining four months may include a combination of:

- a) additional months of hypertension follow-up clinic
- b) additional months of Consult service (up to 4 months)
- c) elective months
- d) research project

Research Stream (6 months)

6 months dedicated to previously identified research project (project and supervisor must be identified prior to initiation of the fellowship).
